

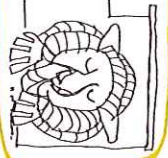
If you explore the crypt you will find some flags. Some of them have animals on them. Can you find the **bumble bee**? What other animals can you see?

You might be surprised to find a **kangaroo** in the crypt but actually we have 2! One is on a flag and one is engraved in glass. Can you find them both?

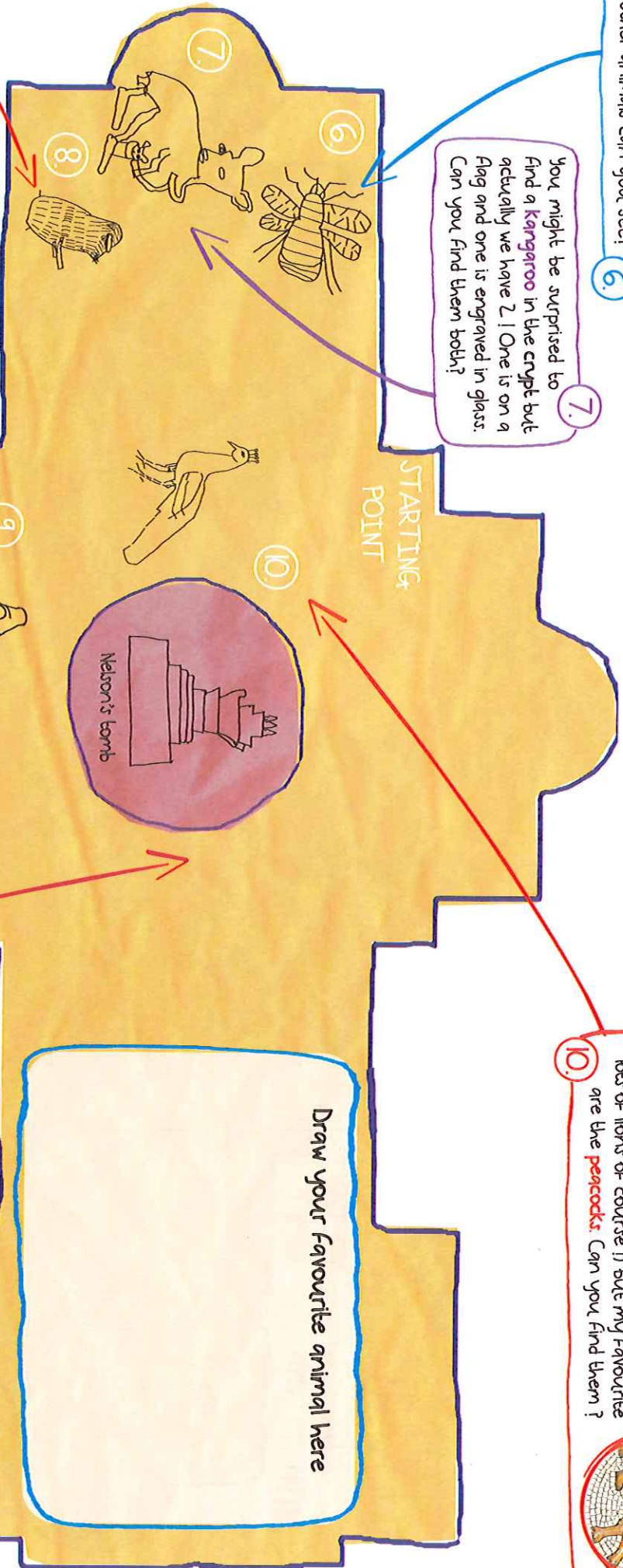

The floor of the crypt is made from very small tiles fixed together to make patterns and pictures. It is a giant mosaic. You can see star fish, thistles, a sun, a moon (and lots of lions of course!) but my favourite are the **peacocks**. Can you find them?
